


# CORONAVIRUS - Surrey's response so far...

**1,491** welfare visits to extremely vulnerable people



**3,805** calls to the community helpline and **299** online forms handled



**125** rooms secured to meet shortfall of accommodation for homeless people



**1,330** food boxes sent out from the Surrey Community Hub to extremely vulnerable people



**23%** more waste and mixed recycling than usual has been collected from homes in Surrey



Over **37,000** donations of PPE distributed to frontline workers from Surrey businesses



**94.6%** increase in new library membership as people take advantage of online and digital library services



**92%** of household waste and recycling collection services in Surrey are still running



**7,000** new volunteers mobilised in March alone through local Volunteer Centres

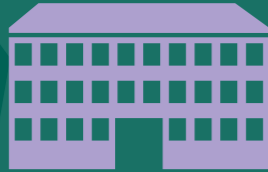
