VICTORY OVER JAPAN (VJ) DAY (15 AUGUST 1945) – YOUR LOCAL REGIMENT


Both VE Day and VJ Day are notable anniversaries for the United Kingdom and the World; marking the end of horrific experiences and great sacrifice. 2020 would have marked significant 75th commemorations, which have obviously been adversely affected by Coronavirus 19.

Your local Regiment of London and the South East, The Princess of Wales's Royal Regiment (PWRR), the Tigers, remembers the sacrifices made by its forebear regiments in the Second World War. Six of our forebear regiments (seven battalions' worth) were involved in the war against Japan:

- 1st Bn Queen's Royal Regiment, India and Burma.
- 2nd Bn Queen's Royal Regiment, a Chindit unit, which went deep behind enemy lines on deep penetration patrols.
- 2nd Bn Buffs. 1944-45. Burma.
- 2nd Bn East Surreys. Malaya, then fall of Singapore.
- 9th Royal Sussex. 1944-45. Burma.
- 4th Bn Queen's Own Royal West Kent Regiment, a Territorial battalion, which
 defended Kohima and included the courageous actions of Lance Corporal Jack
 Harman VC. A Kohima Corporal is appointed in every PWRR battalion, each year, to
 acknowledge his bravery and the recent success of the appointed individual.
- 1st Bn Middlesex. Fall of Hong Kong.
