THE KING'S AWARDS FOR ENTERPRISE



The King's Awards for Enterprise are the most prestigious awards for UK organisations, recognising and rewarding their outstanding achievements in the fields of Innovation, International Trade, Sustainable Development and Promoting Opportunity (through social mobility).

Is your business eligible to apply?

To apply for The King's Award for Enterprise your organisation must:

- Be based in the UK (including the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man)
- Have a good compliance record with HM Revenue and Customs
- Be a self-contained enterprise that markets its own products or services and is under its own management
- Have at least 2 full-time UK employees or part-time equivalents
- Demonstrate strong corporate social responsibility

Each of the award categories has additional entry criteria which you can view on our website.
